Leveled Classes

We offer levels for ages 11 years old and up to meet the needs of our students as they advance. Students in a Level 2 or Level 3 class need final approval from the teacher before being enrolled in the class to ensure that all students are placed in the class that is best suited for them and will provide them the opportunity for the most growth.

Level 1 - designed for the beginner dancer who has little to no dance experience. Focus at this level will be on building the technical foundations of the dance style that the dancer can build upon.

Level 2 - designed for students who have mastered the basic technical elements of the dance style and are ready to build on those elements with learning intermediate level skills and refining their technique.

Level 3 - designed for the more skilled dancer who can execute the intermediate level skills with strong technique and is ready to be challenged with more complex dance steps and longer combinations.

Why do I have to take Ballet if I want to take Lyrical or Contemporary?

Ballet is the foundation for all dance techniques, and it is especially important to have ballet training to be successful in a lyrical or contemporary class. Ballet teaches proper body placement and alignment as well as helps the dancer gain the correct muscle strength to keep them safe as they work on their lyrical or contemporary skills. Taking ballet will provide dancers with the tools they need to excel in their other classes.

What do I wear to class?

Both places have class lists and suggested items for you to purchase to make shopping for dance clothes convenient for you. The clothes on the lists are not required, and you are welcome to use or buy your own dance clothes as long as they meet the criteria for the dress code for your class.

What shoes do I need?

The required shoes are listed on the dress code page of our website. You can purchase the shoes you need through our dance studio's own online Dance Boutique, or on our studio's Discount Dance page. Once you click on the link for either store, you will see a list of classes. If you click on your class, you will see the required shoes for the class.

Please Note: Shoes for most classes will be on our dance studio's online Dance Boutique, but tap shoes for older classes will need to be purchased from Discount Dance or another dance store. Hip Hop classes do not have a required shoe, but you will find suggestions if you need to purchase shoes for Hip Hop.
